Length of the study abroad/exchange period at Temple: one (1) year or one (1) semester

- Study Abroad: Typically, up to 10 students from one institution at any given time
- Exchange: Typically 4 semesters per academic year (Fall-Spring)*

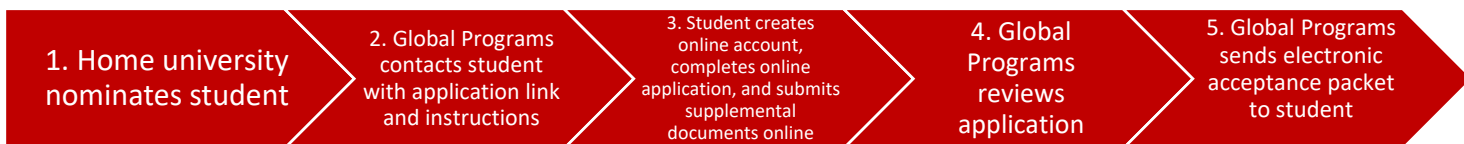

Supplemental application documents required:

- I-20 application (separate online application)
 - Financial documentation
 - Copy of biographical page of passport
- List of current semester courses
- Official language scores
- Course registration process form
- Official transcript(s)
- Housing deposit form (if applicable)

Qualifications for Study Abroad and Exchange Students

- **Undergraduate (bachelor's) students:** full-time enrollment at home university for at least 1 academic year
 - GPA: approx. 3.00/4.00 or higher (80% or 3.3/4.5); Students must maintain 2.0 GPA at Temple.
 - Official TOEFL (79 IBT, 550 ITP), IELTS (6.0), or Duolingo English Test (110) scores*
- Graduate (master's) students: case-by-case, please contact us for more details regarding master's students

Semester Dates

Orientation takes place during the week before classes begin. Students will be notified of arrival dates after acceptance. Tentative dates of academic year 2024 at Temple University:

- Fall 2023 semester starts (Monday) August 28, 2023 and ends (Tuesday) December 19, 2023
- Spring 2024 semester starts (Tuesday) January 16, 2024 and ends (Tuesday) May 7, 2024
